"Under the NSW Occupational Health and Safety Act 2000, employers have a duty of care to ensure health, safety and welfare of their employees," the Premier said.
- It is an established fact that second hand smoke kills an estimated 70 + NSW bar workers every year - our biggest cause of workplace death. Second hand smoke also affects the health of non-smoking patrons including children.
- Current legislation fails to protect staff and patrons in all areas of pubs, clubs, cafes and bars from this deadly hazard.
- 80% of people don't smoke and most support a total ban on smoking in our pubs, clubs, cafes and bars. Don't be part of the silent majority. Tell Morris Iemma to stop it now.
